### Ifield MayFayre 2020

After much thought and consideration, it is with deep regret and heavy hearts that the Ifield

Mayfayre Committee has made the difficult decision to cancel Ifield Mayfayre 2020. Whilst the UK Government hasn't directly published any regulations for events at present,

we feel it would be irresponsible of us to press ahead with running the event. Our reasons are...

• With the prediction of the further spread of this virus, with the peak currently set to

be around April/May, we fear we may struggle with manpower since the event relies

solely on volunteers.

- The success of the event relies on the support of the local community who may choose not to attend the event if the current predictions materialise.
- The event area is relatively small, potentially increasing the risk of infection especially to vulnerable groups of our community.
- It would be very difficult for us to increase the provision of running water and soap to enable hand washing.
- We may be forced to cancel the event through government edict, as has already occurred in other European countries, as this popular community event attracts over three thousand people.

We are currently looking into the feasibility of the Grand Raffle going ahead later in the summer, further details will be published shortly.

We look forward to your continued support and hope you will join us for Ifield MayFayre next year – Bank Holiday Monday 3rd May 2021.
